Electric Toothbrushes

Are you using yours correctly?

- What amount of toothpaste is appropriate (for any toothbrush)?
 - * Believe it or not, just the size equivalent of a small pea.
- How much pressure should be applied with the toothbrush onto tooth surfaces?
 - * As soon as you feel the bristles against your tooth, that's as much pressure as you should apply this allows the bristles full range of motion. Using greater force would actually be harmful.
- For what duration of time should you brush?
 - * Until it turns off. Most electronic toothbrushes are equipped with a 2-minute timer.
- Does an electronic toothbrush replace flossing?
 - * The most advanced toothbrush will not substitute for flossing.
- How often should the brush head be replaced?
 - * Every three months. Though the bristles may not appear worn, the bristles stiffen over time. Prolonged use of a brush head with stiffened bristles would be harmful.
